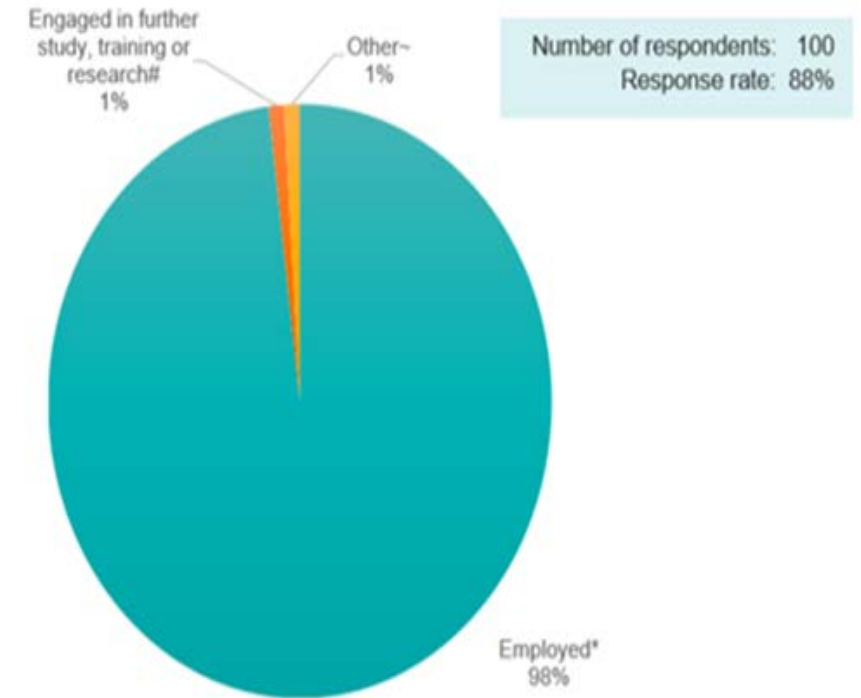


BA (hons) PITE with QTS

Most important activity of students six months after completing their course

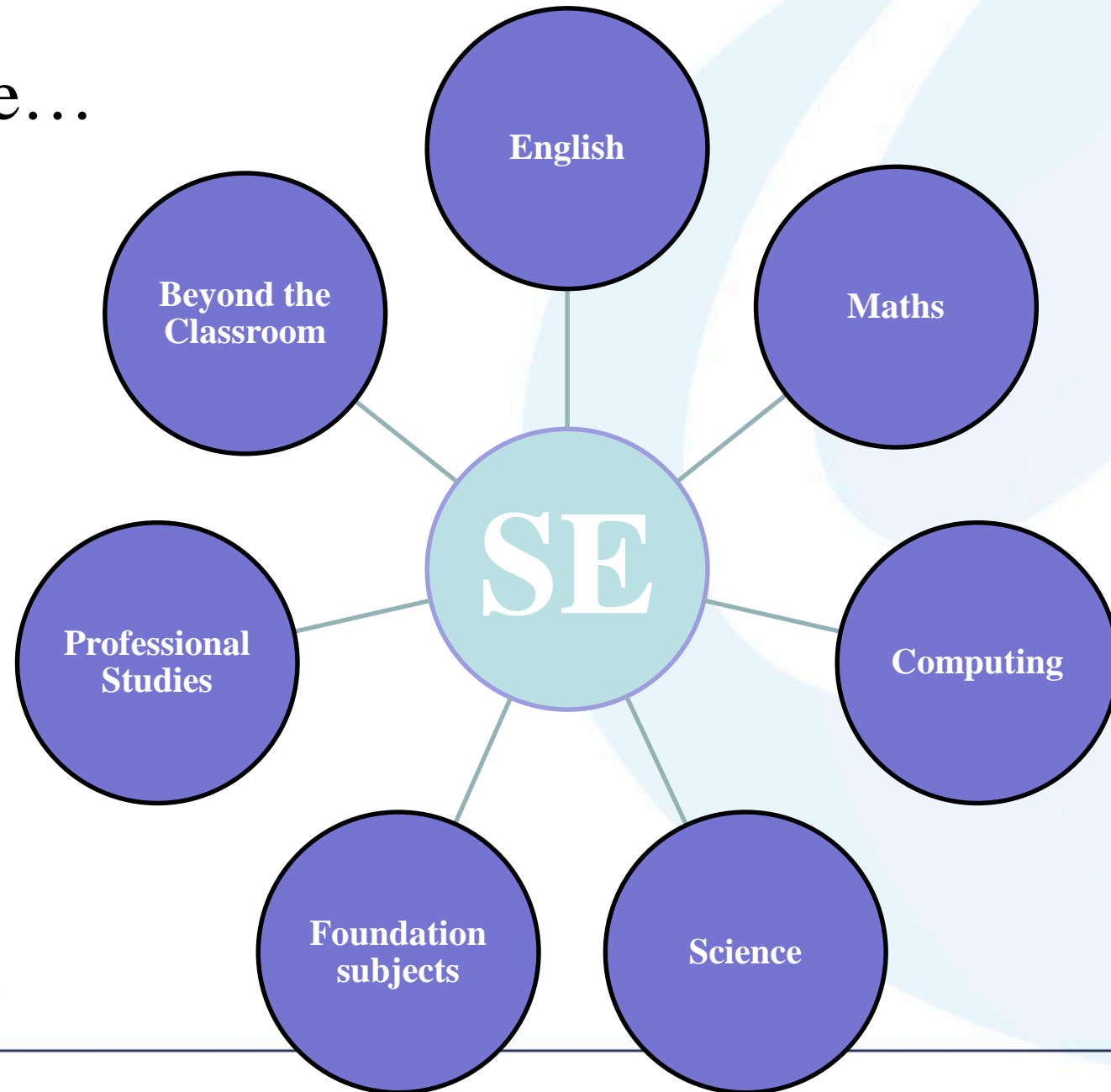


* Full or part-time (including self-employed/freelance, voluntary or other unpaid work, developing a professional portfolio/creative practice or on an internship)

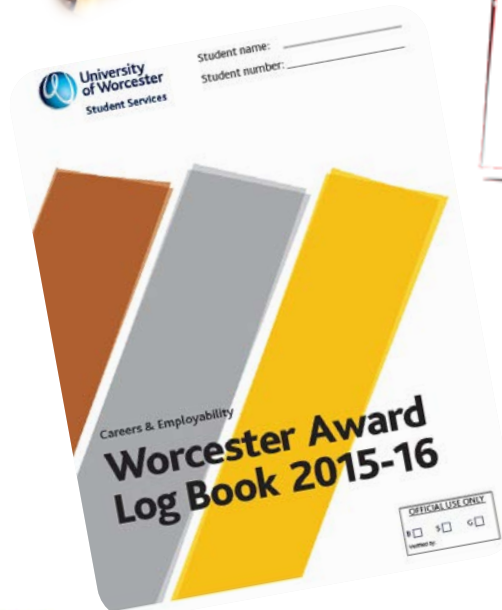

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Entry requirements - PITE

UW
Equivalency
tests

- GCSE Grade C/4 or above English
- GCSE Grade C/4 or above Maths
- GCSE Grade C/4 or above Science
- UCAS points – 112

- Numeracy skills test
- Literacy skills test

Passing the Professional Skills Test

- The first three attempts are free of charge
- Subsequent tests - payment of £19.25 per test
- The pass mark depends on the difficulty of the test
- The tests remain valid for three years from the date passed
- Must have applied for a teacher training course before the tests can be taken.
