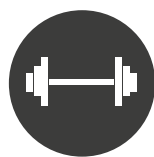


GET SPORTY



BASKETBALL

Basketball plays a significant role in University life. The University of Worcester Arena is home to the Worcester Wolves, a highly successful professional club playing in the British Basketball League and a key event in the student calendar.

GHELUVELT PARK, BARBOURNE ROAD

Named as one of the best parks in the UK, Gheluvelt Park is a memorial park built in honour of those lost in the First World War.

CRIPPLEGATE PARK

Located opposite the County Cricket ground, this park has tennis courts and lots of seating areas. It's also a venue for events held throughout the year.

MALVERN HILLS

The Malvern Hills have been described as a 'mountain range in miniature', with the eight-mile ridge containing some of the oldest rocks in Britain. You can try horse riding, mountain biking, orienteering and hang gliding there too. Enjoy climbing to the highest point at Worcestershire Beacon.

HAN BAO

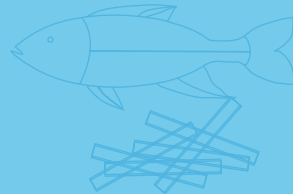
All beef. No drama. Gourmet burger and cocktail bar located on Foregate Street.

THE HANGAR, STUDENTS' UNION

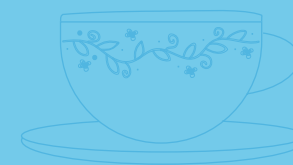
If you are looking for somewhere to take a break between lectures, or relax and enjoy yourself in the evenings, the Students' Union Hangar bar is the ideal place.

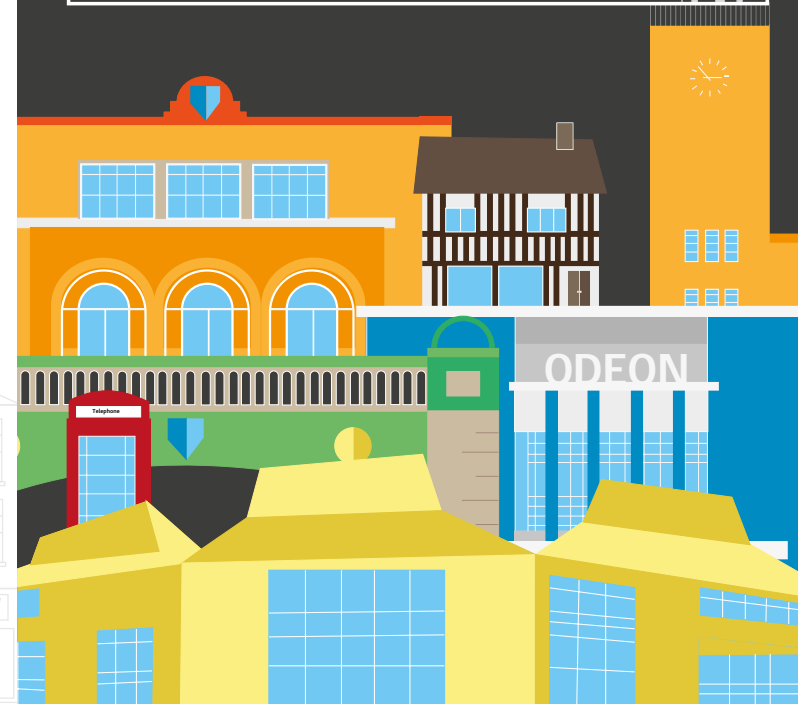

THE HIVE

Our award-winning library offers over a quarter of a million books and twelve miles of archive collection and is open 7 days a week, 8:30am-10pm.

RIVERSIDE
